

DRUG WORLD PHARMACY AT-A-GLANCE

Drug World is the pharmacy that packages Eisner Camp's camper medication.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- STEP 1:** Go to www.drugworld.com to register your camper.
- STEP 2:** Contact your doctor to send your camper's prescriptions directly to Drug World.
- STEP 3:** Drug World will package your camper's medications in individual doses, each labeled with your child's name and the specific time for administration.
- STEP 4:** Drug World will deliver your camper's individually packed medications directly to camp.
- STEP 5:** The Eisner Camp Health Center staff will simply open the packet and hand your child their medication.

WHEN DO FAMILIES NEED TO REGISTER BY?

1st Session: June 1st

If you submit the form after the deadline,

Full Summer: June 1st

Drug World Pharmacy will apply a late fee of **\$100**.

2nd Session: July 1st

Unfortunately, no exceptions will be made.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- Drug World charges a packaging fee per camper. Eisner Camp covers part of the fee, and you will be charged the remaining \$60.
- You will be responsible for your regular copays, and OTC medications will be priced competitively.
- Families who miss the Drug World Pharmacy deadline will incur a late fee of \$100.

YOU MUST REGISTER WITH DRUG WORLD IF YOUR CAMPER NEEDS:

- ANY Daily OR As Needed medications
- OTC Medications, Vitamins or Supplements in any form
- All medications for camp must be processed through Drug World to ensure compliance and safety.

If you bring any meds on Opening Day, you must still register with Drug World and pay a \$100 late fee.

ARE THERE EXCEPTIONS?

- Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- If an exception is granted, any fees paid will be reimbursed.
- To be eligible, you must be listed on the "Bringing Meds" list compiled by Drug World.

All approved medications must arrive at camp on Opening Day in new, sealed, and unexpired condition, accompanied by a physician's note with directions.
